## 1.0 Introduction

The Road Fund was established under the Section 21(3) of the Public Financial Management and Accountability Act 2011 and operationalized by the Finance (Road Fund) Regulations 2012. The main reason for establishing the Fund was to shift the burden of financing maintenance of Lesotho's road infrastructure from general taxes collected by the central fiscus to road user fees, and to close the persistent financing gaps that characterized road maintenance prior to the establishment of the Fund.

### 1.1 Overall Requirements

The prospective bidder must demonstrate the following quantities:

- Technical competence to carry out the proposed assignment and experience of similar work.
- Must be a certified supplier of the proposed assignment
- Must provide Details of Similar contracts carried out (minimum of 2 years' experience) with their Cost, Time frame, Location and Employer with a reference of satisfactory completion (only **purchase orders, contracts or certificates of completion** will be considered).
- Must Submit bid security of 2% of a tendered amount, payable to the Road Fund. It has to be from a financial institution or bank recognised by the Central Bank of Lesotho.
- If the bidder is successful, 10% of Tendered Amount will be required as performance guarantee, to be provided by the bidder before being issued with a purchase order. It has to be from a financial institution or bank recognised by the Central Bank of Lesotho.
- **Site Visits for this tender are compulsory.** Refer to Appendix 1 for a detailed schedule.

## 2.0 Instructions to Bidders

### 2.1 Confidentiality

The Road Fund Standard Procurement Agreement General Terms and Conditions shall apply.

## 2.2 Invitation for Bids

### 2.2.1 Background and requirements:

The Road Fund Secretariat invites bids from eligible and qualified category E (Roads Directorate) or category C (Building Design Services) Contractors to maintain Road Fund Toll facilities in Sani Pass, Botha-Bothe, Maputsoe, Peka, Mafeteng, Mohale's Hoek and Quthing Border Posts. The scope of work is provided in Table 1 below:

Minor civil works, repairs to existing tolling booths, roads patchwork, and road markings within 20m of Boom Gate on either side as specified in the Bill of Quantities.

2.2.3 Request for clarifications may be sent in writing to this email address [procurement@roadfund.org.ls](mailto:procurement@roadfund.org.ls) not later than 5th March 2026.

2.2.4 Bids must be delivered to the address under clause Eight (8) below, on or before 20th March 2026 at 10:30hrs. Late bids will be rejected. Tenders will be opened in the presence of the Tenderers and/or their representatives who choose to attend in person at Road Fund Secretariat Boardroom on the same date 20th March 2026 at 11:00hrs. Telefax and Email Tenders will not be accepted.

2.2.5 Qualification requirements as fully described in the Bidding Documents, include the requirements listed in the sub-clauses below:

2.2.6 A bidder having a company registered locally in terms of the Laws of the Kingdom of Lesotho and meeting the following minimum requirements:

2.2.7 A bidder registered with the Roads Directorate in category E or Building Design Services in category C;

2.2.8 A bidder with a minimum of three (3) years' experience in similar works and scope (Provide Proof in the form of contract signed or purchase order received and completion certificate).

2.2.9 Bidders are also expected to provide the following mandatory documents:

2.2.10 (c) Valid Traders licence/ Business I.D. for Builder and Contractor, (d) Valid Tax Clearance Certificate, (e) Category Certificate from either RD (Category E) or BDS (Category C), (f) Power of Attorney for the Authorised Signatory (Including Sole Proprietors), (g) Letter of Intent to Form a Joint Venture (Only for Companies intending to form Joint Ventures), (h) Filled and Signed Contractor's bid, (i) Bid validity of Ninety (90) days, (j) Certificate of Bona Fide Tendering (Filled, Signed and Stamped with Supplier's stamp), (k) Bid security of 2% of the bid amount, in the form of a Bank Guarantee valid for One hundred and twenty (120) days and (l) One (1) Original and Three (3) Copies of the submissions.

2.2.11 Failure to provide any of the documentation listed above will disqualify the bidder from further evaluation.

2.2.12 A mandatory bidder's conference/site visit will be held as per schedule herein attached as Appendix 1 of the tender document.

## 3.0 Evaluation of Bids

A Bidder for this Contract, will be selected under a Competitive Bidding (CB) method, using Single Envelope, Without Prequalification of Bidders, and application of domestic margin of preferences shall be applicable.

### 3.1 Evaluation Criteria

- i. Compliance to Tender Conditions;
- ii. Technical Capability (70%);
- iii. Financial Capability (30%).

#### 3.1.1 Compliance to Tender Conditions

All bidders must comply with the conditions as stipulated in **2.1** above. Bidders who fail comply with any of the conditions in **2.1** will not be evaluated further.

#### 3.1.2 Evaluation of the Technical Solution

Only Bidders who have complied with **2.1** will be evaluated at this stage.

- The Bidder with the lowest competitive price, "L" will be awarded 100%

- And Bidders with Price, “P” will be awarded the financial Score = (L/P)\*100  
Total Combined Score = (70% of Technical + 30% of Financial).

## 7.0 Fraud and Corruption

The Road Fund (Employer) requires that recipients as well as bidders, suppliers, contractors and consultants under the Road Fund Financed contracts observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. Pursuant to this policy, the Road Fund:

1. Defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:
  - 1.1.1. **Corrupt practice** means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution;
  - 1.1.2. **Fraudulent Practice** means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution contract;

1.1.3. **Collusive Practice** means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without knowledge of the recipient, designed to establish did prices at artificial, noncompetitive levels; and

1.1.4. **Coercive Practice** means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the procurement process or affect the execution of a contract;

2. Will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has directly through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question;
3. Will sanction a firm or individual, including declaring them ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a Road Fund financed contract if it at any time determines that they have directly through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent or coercive practices in competing for or in executing a Road Fund Financed Contract; and
4. Will have the right to require that a provision be included in bidding documents and in contracts financed by the Road Fund, requiring bidders, suppliers, contractors and consultants to permit the Road Fund to inspect their accounts and records and other documents relating to the bid submission and contract performance and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Road Fund.
